Purpose

To provide additional guidance with respect to recently revisions/updates made to WC's policy GEN-050-02 Incident Reporting.

Background

Information and complaints involving criminal fraud, waste, abuse or other criminal activity must be reported immediately through the Incident Reporting System of the Department of Labor (DOL) Office of Inspector General (OIG), Office of Investigation, Room S5514, 200 Constitution Avenue NW. Washington, D.C. 20210, or to the corresponding Regional Inspector General for investigations, with a copy simultaneously provided to the Employment and Training Administration (ETA). The hotline number is 1 800 347-3756. Complaints of a non-criminal nature are handled under the procedures set forth in §667-505 or through the DOL Incident Reporting System. [20 CFR §667-630]
