Programs Services and Activities – Adult, Dislocated Workers and Youth

Purpose

To announce the publication and effective date for implementation of revisions made to the following policies:

- **ADW-030-01 Eligibility for WIOA Title I Services
Adult and Dislocated Workers – under Sec. VI (C)(4) and (5)
Determining Family Size and Income – Income inclusions and exclusions – revised list included; and**
- **YTH-040-01 Eligibility for WIOA Title I Services – Youth
Sec. III (D) and (E) Determining Family Size and Income – Income inclusions and exclusions – revised list included.**

Background

Under Title I of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), low-income individuals and those with barriers to employment are priority populations for funding and services. Income is one of the factors for determining eligibility for the Adult, Dislocated Worker and Youth programs.

Summary of Revisions

Includable items have been revised to include the following:

- Military family allotments or other regular support from an absent family member or someone not living in the household.
- Money received from such sources:
 - Unemployment Compensation;
 - Child Support Payments;
 - Old age and survivors' insurance benefits received under Sec. 202 of the Social Security Act. (42 U.S.C. 402)
