**Re: Income Guidelines — Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL) and
Poverty Guidelines**

In accordance with the Workforce Investment Act State Compliance Policy Section 1.7, we are issuing income guidelines effective May 29, 2019 to assist Local Workforce Investment Board staff in determining eligibility for low-income individuals.

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services published their poverty guidelines in the Federal Register on February 1, 2019. The most recent U.S. Department of Labor LLSIL figures were published in the Federal Register on May 29, 2019.
