Question No.1

Dear Sir/Madam:

The RFP requires the following insurances please see questions in red below

A. The proposer must be licensed to provide the required services under this solicitation. The selected proposer will be required to provide the following:

- Copy of valid State Business License;
- Copy of valid City Business License;

Is it sufficient for a proposer to agree to acquire the licenses if awarded the contract as opposed to applying for a license when proposer does not do other business in the State at the time of application?

- and
- Copy of valid Certificate of Liability Insurance.

As a sole proprietor/ consultant commercial liability insurance is not available. Proposer has explored this in the past. Is this something that can be negotiated as this is not a risk area for a consultant?

B. The proposal requires Workers Compensation Insurance. If proposer is not legally required to have Workers Compensation as proposer does not employ at least 3 individuals is this requirement waived?

Response to Question No. 1

- The requirement is to provide a copy of the proposer's local valid business license at the time of executing an agreement with Workforce Connections.
- Matters related to the Certificate of Liability Insurance (CLI) can be negotiated with executive management at the time of executing an agreement with Workforce Connections.
- After further research, there is no requirement for Workers Compensation Insurance.
