### **Purpose**

To provide additional guidance and technical assistance in relation to overall provisions, established requirements, and processes that govern high-risk designation and the framework for the implementation of sanctions. In addition, to announce the publication and effective date for implementation of revisions/updates made to the following policy:

### **Admin-010-02 Sanctions and Resolutions for Noncompliance**

### **Background**

In general, recipients and sub-recipients of a Federal award under Title I of WIOA are subject to the Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements codified at Title 2 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 200, Appendices I through XI, as applicable, including any exceptions identified by the Department of Labor (DOL) codified at 2 CFR Part 2900.

Each sub-recipient must establish and maintain effective internal controls over the sub-award that provide reasonable assurance that the sub-recipient is managing the sub-award in compliance with Federal statutes and regulations, State, local policies and the terms and conditions of the sub-award agreement.

### **Modifications**

- Policy revised in its entirety with the addition of applicable State laws.
- Streamlined process to ensure accountability of sub-recipients in meeting established performance measures, ensuring compliance with established Federal statutes and regulations, State, local policies and the terms and conditions of contracts or sub-award agreements.

### **Action**

Please share this guidance with staff and interested parties as necessary or appropriate.

With the commitment to improve processes and after further research and assessment of established requirements, WC has revised and implemented the above-referenced policy as appropriate. Technical assistance is available upon request.
