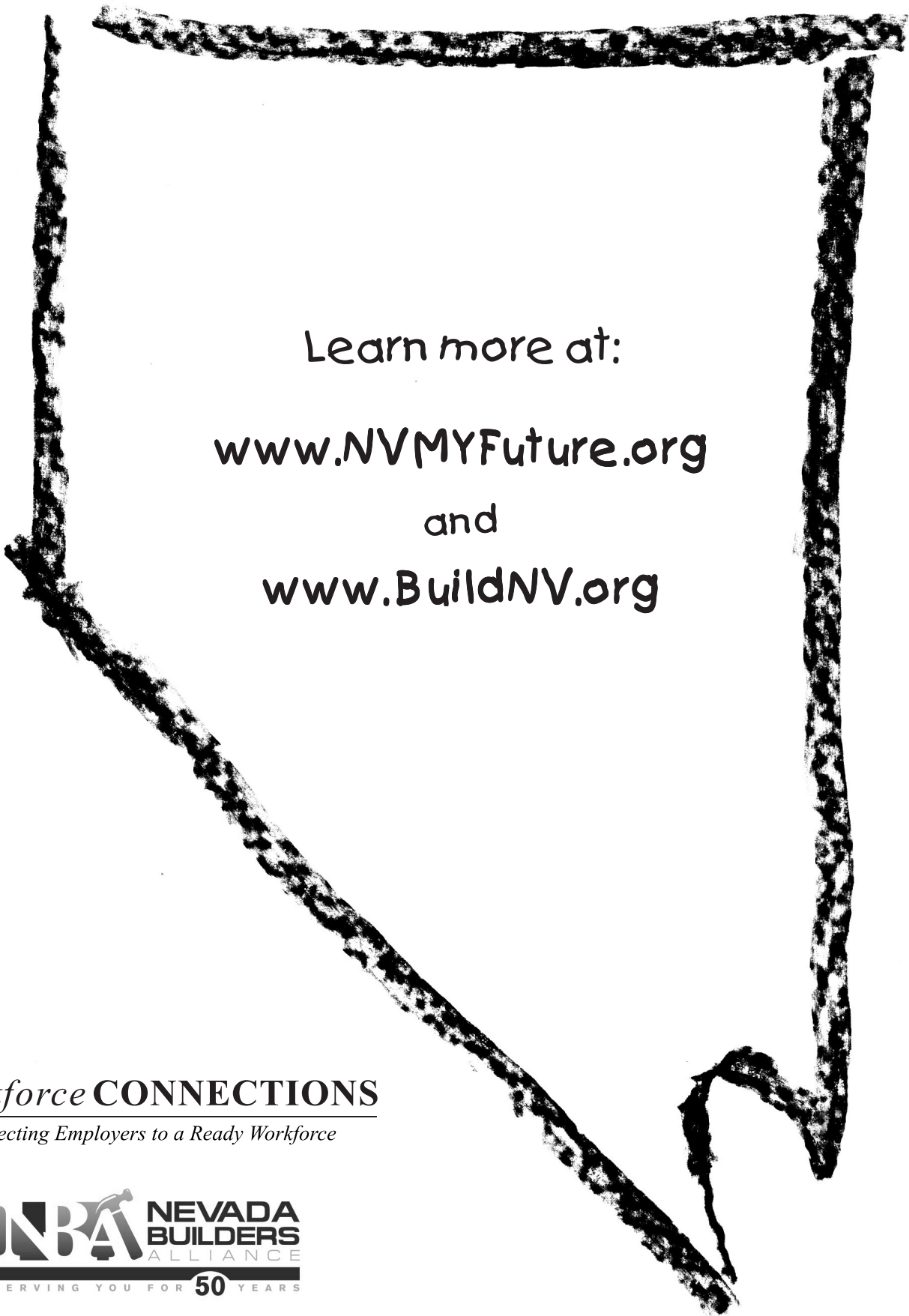


### VERTICAL
